1. Add-on Course on Mushroom Farming

62 college students successfully completed 'Add on course on Mushroom Farming'. This 45-hour duration course was organized by the Department of Botany w.e.f. 1st September to 30 November 2025 for the skill enhancement of students. This Course on Mushroom Farming was organized with the objective of introducing students to the scientific methods and entrepreneurial opportunities in mushroom cultivation. The course was highly beneficial, as it helped students understand the potential of mushroom farming as a self-employment opportunity. The course aimed to enhance practical skills, promote sustainable agriculture, and create awareness about low-cost income-generating activities.



2. Add-on Course on BeeKeeping

The department of Zoology under the supervision of Coordinator of this program Dr Diljeet Singh started a 30 Hours “Add-On Course on BeeKeeping” during the months of September-October 2025. The course commenced on 23-09-2025 and completed on 27-10-2025. In total, 30 students of the college were enrolled for this course. The course content was divided into theoretical and practical parts including various topics of Apiculture.



3. Add-on Course on “Patrakarita”

4. Add-On Course on Indian Knowledge Systems

This 30 hours course was conducted under the able guidance and leadership of Dr. Anil Kumar Thakur, Principal of the institution. The program was coordinated by Dr. K. Seema, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics. The course commenced on 6th October 2025 and concluded on 14th February 2026. A total of 51 students successfully completed this course, reflecting active participation and keen interest among the learners.

This course was thoughtfully designed to acquaint students with the rich and diverse intellectual traditions of India and to highlight their relevance in contemporary education. The course adopted a learner-centric and interactive pedagogical approach. 5. Add-On Course on Traditional Chamba Rumal Embroidery: A Creative Initiative

The Department of Music, Govt. Arya Degree College, Nurpur organized a 36-hour Add-On Course on Traditional Chamba Rumal Embroidery with the objective of preserving and promoting the rich traditional handicraft of Himachal Pradesh. The course was conducted from 8th October, 2025 to 25th February, 2026. The programme was organized under the able guidance of the Principal, Dr. Anil Kumar Thakur, and was coordinated by Dr. Bharti Bhagsain, Assistant Professor, Department of Music (I). 32 students actively participated in this add-on course. The students received both theoretical and practical training in the traditional techniques, decorative styles, colour combinations, and cultural significance of Chamba Rumal embroidery from Mrs. Dinesh Kumari, President Awardee. Under her expert guidance, the students not only learned the intricate techniques of this unique folk art but also gained knowledge about its historical background and commercial potential.





6. The Add-On Course on “Women Role in Local Society”
