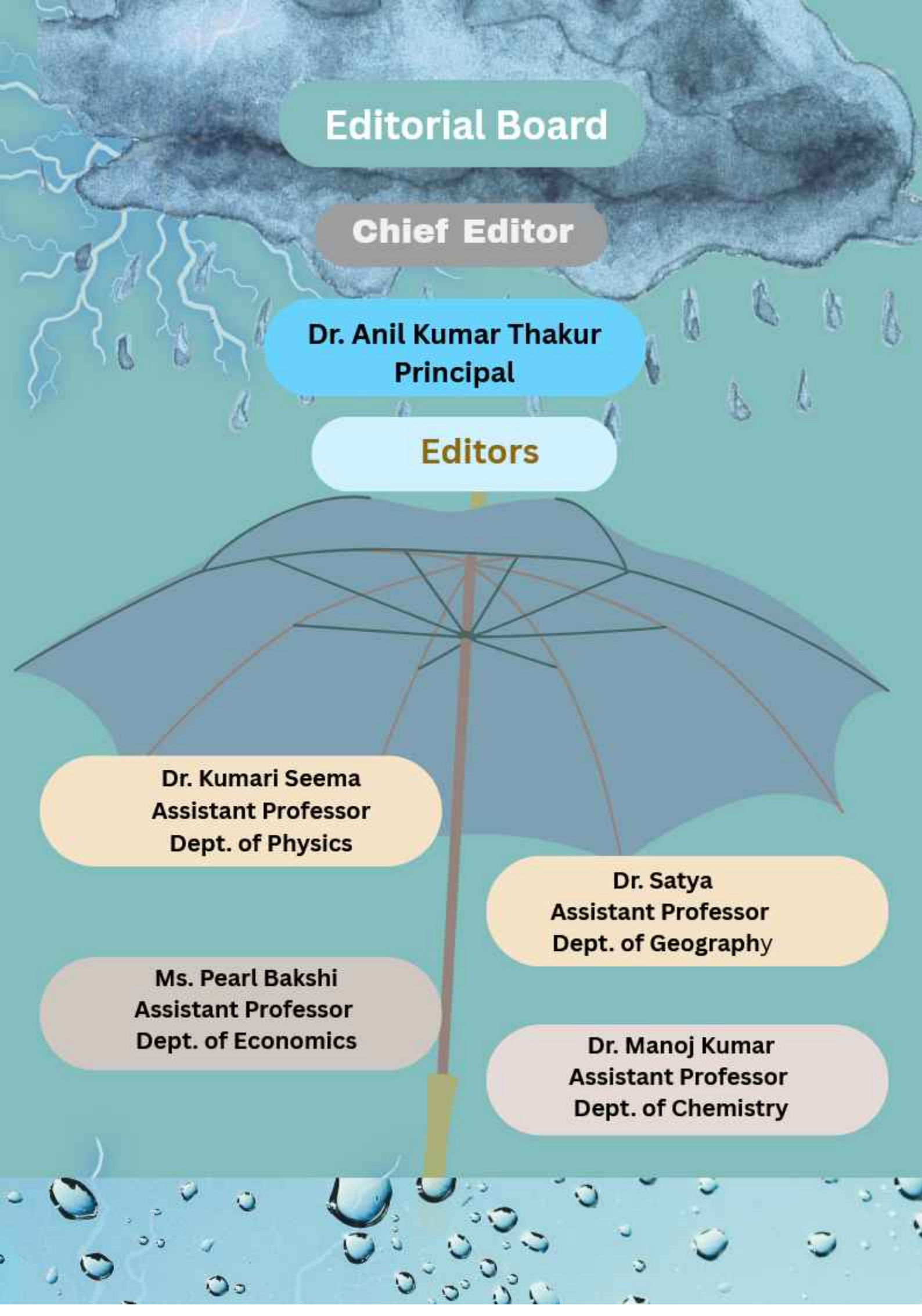
About the Institution

Govt. Arya Degree College, Nurpur, Dist. Kangra (H.P.) recognized under section 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act 1956, is a constituent college of Himachal Pradesh University Shimla. It was established as Arya College for Girls in June 1978 with a meagre strength of 20 girls. The institution was started in the sacred memory of Swami Dayanand Saraswati, whose name stands among the greatest social and religious reformers of modern India, who propounded that knowledge should be imparted without prejudice of caste, creed and sex and that the basic purpose of propagating real education is to inculcate love for Indian cultural ethics in consonance with the Vedic ideas of universal brotherhood.

The Arya College for Girls was taken over by the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh on 25th June 2002 as a co-educational institution and named as Govt. Arya Degree College, Nurpur with only Humanities. From the academic session 2009-10, this institution also started Science (Medical & non-medical) and commerce classes, thereby fulfilling the long-standing demand and aspirations of the people of this area.

The University Grants Commission launched an employment-oriented scheme on skill development as a part of college/ university education. This vocational degree programme (B. Voc.) started in our college w.e.f. June 2017 with two courses having 40 seats each, one in Retail Management and the other in Hospitality & Tourism.

Having made a mark on the educational horizon of the Himachal Pradesh University, our college strives to create an environment conducive to continuous academic, and co-curricular activities and holistic development of students as well as staff members. For this purpose, consistent efforts have always been made by all stakeholders to foster, encourage and motivate ideas and put them into practice. College tries to inculcate all the values enshrined in our constitution; the values of liberty, equality, justice and brotherhood. We encourage a sense of tolerance for different cultures and opinions among our students.

An E-pledge program on the theme “ Say Yes to Life and No to Drugs” on the official website of Narcotics Control Bureau , Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt of India was organised through Google Form on 30-07-2025 to 31-07-2025.

A Mass Pledge and Awareness Program against Drug and Substance Abuse was organised in the college campus on 13-08-2025. In this program , the officiating principal along with all staff members and students of the college participated. In the beginning of the program, Dr Diljeet Singh, Assoc Prof, Dept of Zoology provided detailed information about the types of drugs / substances, their abuse and addiction in Himachal Pradesh. He further said that various kinds of awareness activities against drug abuse have been carried out under the campaign “Nasha Mukh Bharat Abhiyan” which was started 4-5 years ago by the Government of India. He threw light upon the status of drug abuse in the state and said that more than 5000 cases of drug abuse / addicts, drug peddlers and drug smugglers have been recorded by the police department of Himachal Pradesh during the last few years in all districts of Himachal Pradesh. However, more cases of drug abuse have been recorded in Kangra, Hamirpur, Shimla and Kullu districts of the state. Many cases of drug suppliers from border area states like Punjab and Jammu & Kashmir have been also observed and alarming signals of drug abuse and supply like cannabis, heroin, opiates and other narcotics among youth in the state have been reported. More than 1000 students of the college from all streams including arts, commerce, science and vocation took the pledge against drug abuse and attended the awareness program.

A total of 139 students of the college participated in it and submitted their pledges alongwith downloaded certificates through the Google form to the Anti Drug and Substance Abuse Committee of the college.

1. Indigenous Healing Traditions



On dated 23 August 2025, a National Level Seminar Series on Indian Traditional Knowledge System was started by Internal Quality Assurance Cell and Research Development and Innovation Committee of Govt. Arya Degree College. On this occasion three scientists, Dr. Hardeep Singh, Dr. Rachna and Dr. Vivek Dogra from Regional Ayurveda Research Institute, Mandi, Himachal Pradesh, CCRS (Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences), Ministry of Ayush, Government of India delivered their talks on 'Traditional Knowledge of Plants and its Relevance in Modern Society'. The keynote speakers of the seminar, college principal, staff members and students were welcomed by the seminar convener Dr. Rakesh Kumar. The speakers highlighted the importance of traditional knowledge, need for its documentation, patents and biopiracy. They also explained the use of plant parts or plant products in our daily life. They focussed upon the conservation of all these plants. College Principal Dr. Anil Kumar Thakur in his lecture highlighted the importance of local plants, their uses since the ancient times and conservation methods. College students Sahajdeep Kaur, Ankita Choudhary, Shalini Devi, Neeharika, Vanshika and Akriti Sharma also brought some plants from local areas which were being used traditionally. These students demonstrated how these plants are used in their areas. At the end of the seminar vote of thanks was presented by Dr. Diljeet Singh. A total of 100 participants attended the seminar.

NSS Certificate Distribution Programme

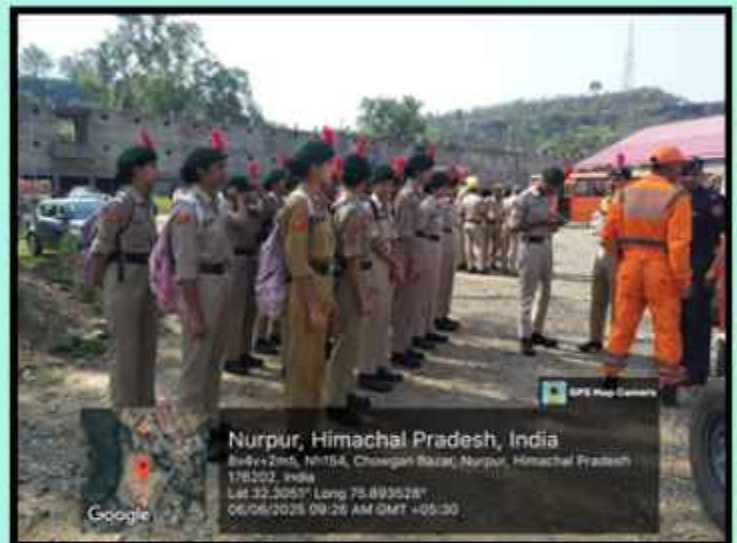

TREMBLE AND RESPOND: A MOCK DRILL ON EARTHQUAKE

A mock drill on earthquake preparedness exercise was conducted across Kangra district under the aegis of NDMA and SDMA. Which was organised by the Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM) of Nurpur. 23 NCC cadets of the college to assist in these exercises—suggesting their likely involvement in evacuation and first-response roles. The drill scenario simulated a high-magnitude earthquake, with staged building collapse, landslides, and fire events. Cadets were employed in crowd management, guiding ‘victims’ to safety zones, helping administer basic first aid, and supporting the operational coordination with civil defence, medical teams, and police. This exercise aimed to evaluate emergency response times, communication protocols among agencies, and community-level preparedness—especially critical given Kangra district’s ranking in seismic Zone IV-V vulnerability. Lessons learned from the drill will inform future planning and strengthen local disaster resilience frameworks.

Commemorating 26 years of Kargil Vijay divas in a heartfelt tribute to the valiant soldiers of Kargil War, Kargil Vijay Diwas is observed every year on July 26 to mark India's victory over Pakistan in the 1999 war. India had launched 'Operation Vijay' to evict Pakistani forces who had managed to stealthily occupy strategic positions in the mountains in Kargil, aiming to sever the transport link between Kashmir and Ladakh. On July 26 in 1999, the Indian Army announced the successful culmination of Operation Vijay, declaring victory after a nearly three-month battle in Kargil. To inculcate patriotism and to remember the supreme sacrifices of the Indian soldiers, the NCC Unit of Govt. Arya Degree College, Nurpur organised the screening of the Hindi movie "Amaran: The Sacrifice" in the college premises. Arogya Vanam in New Campus

24 July 2025, Government Arya Degree College Nurpur, in collaboration with the Forest Department, planted trees in the forest land near (near Theru Wali Mata Temple and newly under construction building of the college) in village Ghain Lagore Panchayat under the campaign Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam. In this campaign, about 55 volunteers from the college, Eco Club, National Service Scheme, Rover and Ranger Club, along with the college Principal Dr. Anil Kumar Thakur, club in-charge and teachers, Divisional Forest Officer Mr. Amit Sharma, Assistant Forest Conservator Mr. Nishant Parashar and forest division employees planted about 150 wild and medicinal plants of different types. National Library Day

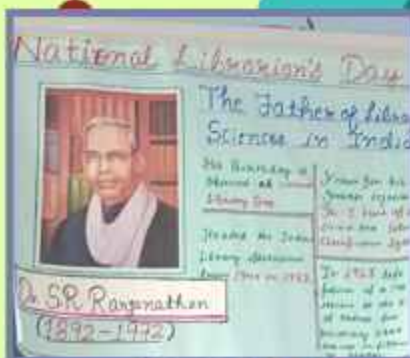
Department of Mathematics

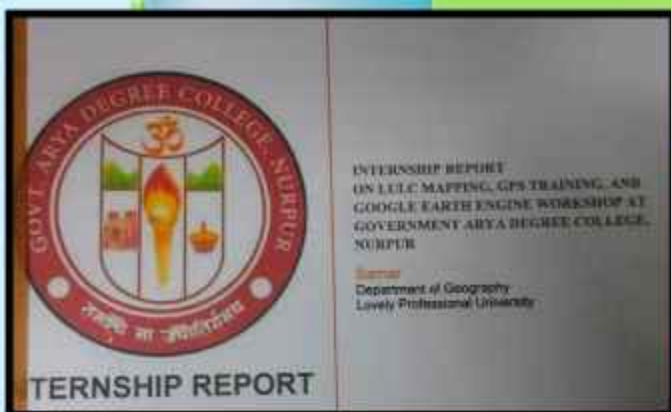

Advancing Geospatial Skills: An Academic Internship

An academic internship was conducted for Mr. Samar, a student from the Department of Geography, Lovely Professional University, from 13th June 2025 to 25th July 2025. The activity was carried out during regular college hours under the supervision of faculty member in the Department of Geography at Govt. Arya Degree College, Nurpur. The internship involved hands-on training in remote sensing and GIS techniques. He completed a research-based project titled "Spatio-Temporal Land Use Land Cover Analysis of Lahaul and Spiti Using Landsat-7 and Sentinel-2 Data". The project was carried out using Google Earth Engine, a cloud-based geospatial analysis platform. In addition to his project work, he actively participated in departmental academic activities, including student assistance during practical sessions and data handling tasks. exposure to geospatial technologies, remote sensing data analysis, and academic teaching methods. It helped Samar develop practical skills in GIS and satellite image interpretation.
