3. National level Seminar series on IKS in the college.

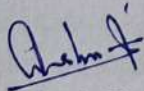
Minutes of the Meeting:

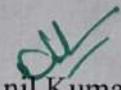
The minutes of the previous meeting were read out before the committee members and approved unanimously for the actions taken.

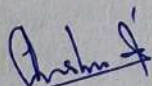
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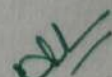
The minutes of the previous meeting were read out before the committee members and approved unanimously for the actions taken.

4. To carry out Pre and Post admission counselling of students.

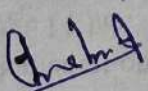
Minutes of Meeting:

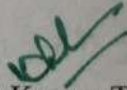
The minutes of the previous meeting were read out before the committee members and approved unanimously for the actions taken.
